

Charles Wyborny was born December 16, 1882, at Manley, Iowa, of parents Vratislav and Mary Rychlik Wyborny. He attended high school at Manley and the Seminary at Nora Springs, Iowa. Then he taught school near Manley for three years.

Mr. Wyborny was married to Lucie Chalupnik September 5, 1912. He was a rural mail carrier out of Lakefield for over 30 years, retiring June 30, 1950. After retirement, Mr. and Mrs. Wyborny moved to Alexandria, returning to Lakefield in 1966.

He was a member of the Methodist church, the Elks Lodge and the Odd Fellows.

Mr. Wyborny passed away on Sunday morning, April 28, 1968, at the Lakefield hospital at the age of 85.

He is survived by his wife Lucie; one grandson, Charles Wyborny of Farson, Wyoming; one sister, Mildred Wyborny of Lakefield; one brother, Edwin Wyborny of Jackson. He was preceded in death by an infant daughter, Blanch; and a son, Leslie, on September 12, 1959.
